What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to England

Day 2: London

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in London, a city of 8 million people that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own.
- Take a walking tour of London, where you'll see iconic sites such as the Strand, Trafalgar Square, Leicester Square, and Covent Garden.
- Enjoy an authentic fish and chips dinner.

Day 3: London

- On your expertly guided tour of London, see sites such as Big Ben, the Houses of Parliament, and Piccadilly Circus. You might even see the Changing of the Guard at Buckingham Palace (if scheduled).
- Visit St. Paul's Cathedral, one of the most recognizable sights of London. Discover the Whispering Gallery, one of the church's most well known features, where a low whisper can be clearly heard at the other side, 112 feet away. Visit the cathedral's crypt where many people have been buried, including James Barry, Alexander Fleming, and Christopher Wren (St Paul's Cathedral's designer).
- Attend an evening theater performance.

Day 4: London

- Full day to see more of London or [visit Windsor and Stonehenge: Stonehenge stone circles; Windsor Castle, St. George's Chapel; State Apartments.](#)

Day 5: London

- Visit the Tower of London. Enter through thick defensive walls and take a look behind the Tower of London's imposing stony façade. Henry VIII banished two of his wives to this former prison, where Guy Fawkes also spent his final days. But the Tower's most famous occupants—the Crown Jewels—still reside here today. On your tour, behold this jaw-dropping collection of ornate rings, scepters, swords, and royal vestments. Venture outside for a walk through the courtyard, where you can admire the four distinctive turrets rising out of the White Tower. Keep an eye out for the Tower's famous ravens: legend states that the kingdom will fall if any of the six resident ravens ever leaves the Tower Grounds.
- Take a Thames River cruise to Greenwich.
- Visit the Royal Observatory.
- Visit the National Maritime Museum.

Day 6: London

- Full day to see more of London or [visit Oxford and Stratford-upon-Avon: New College; Shakespeare's Birthplace; Gardens at Anne Hathaway's Cottage.](#)

Day 7: Depart for home

Day 7: Paris

- Travel by Eurostar train to Paris.
- Take an expertly guided tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Les Invalides; Eiffel Tower.

Day 8: Paris

- Visit the Louvre.
- Take a walking tour of Paris: Latin Quarter.
